One-Time Setup (Takes 5 Minutes)

To access all academy documents without issues, please complete this simple setup:

Step 1: Install Google Chrome Browser

- Download from: google.com/chrome
- Available for Windows, Mac, iOS, and Android
- Free and recommended for best compatibility

Step 2: Install Google Docs & Sheets Apps

For Mobile Devices (iPhone/iPad/Android):

1. Open your App Store (iOS) or Play Store (Android)
2. Search for "Google Docs" and install
3. Search for "Google Sheets" and install
4. Both apps are completely free

For Desktop/Laptop (Windows/Mac):

- You can access documents directly through Chrome browser
- Or download the desktop apps from: google.com/docs/about

Step 3: Open Documents Properly

- Launch Google Docs or Google Sheets app first (before clicking any links)
- Then click the document links below
- Documents will open in the correct app automatically

 **Common Issue:** If a link doesn't work, it's usually because:

- You haven't installed the Google apps yet
- You're using an outdated browser (not Chrome)
- The app isn't open before you click the link

Pathway 1: Applying from Abroad (Not Currently in Bali)

If you are applying from outside Bali, you may be exempted from the Consultation Visit and Trial Day. You can pre-book your Trial Month directly.

Pathway 2: Currently in Bali

If you are currently in Bali, follow these steps:

1

Read Required Documents

Including the NDA and Admission Policy (linked above) before proceeding

2 Book Consultation Visit

Schedule a consultation visit with the Head of Academy for a tour and discussion

3 Attend Trial Day

After the consultation visit, you can arrange a trial day for your child

4 Complete Enrollment

Based on the trial day experience, proceed with formal enrollment

Important: A Consultation Visit is NOT the same as a Trial Day. Do not skip the Consultation Visit unless you are on the Remote Pathway, as meeting the Head of Academy benefits your student's application.

Trial Period Explained

What is the Trial Period?

The trial period is a crucial evaluation phase that allows both the academy and family to assess whether Skyhawk Academy is the right fit. It typically consists of:

- **Trial Day:** A single day where your child experiences classes, meets teachers and peers
- **Trial Month:** 15 active academy days (based on average active days per month in a year) to fully integrate and evaluate fit

Key Points

- Trial periods are mutual evaluations — for both school and family
- Performance, behavior, and cultural fit are assessed
- Most but not all families proceed to full enrollment after trials
- This selective process maintains the quality of our learning community

Tuition Components

- **Registration Fee:** One-time, non-refundable fee paid upon acceptance
- **Tuition Payment Plans:** Available in 3-month, 6-month, or 12-month payment plans
- **Minimum Enrollment:** 1 year commitment required
- **Additional Fees:** Shown in the Additional Info page of the ratecard sheet

Payment Information

- Sibling discounts apply to additional siblings at the annual rate only
- Fees are subject to semesterly review
- Payment schedules are established upon enrolment but can be changed upon renewal date of payment plan

General Structure

Below is a general overview. For exact dates and holiday schedules, please refer to the Google Sheets calendar above.

Term Structure

- **Term 1:** July – September
- **Term 2:** October – December
- **Term 3:** January – March
- **Term 4:** April – June

Academic year runs from July 1st through June 30th, divided into four 3-month terms.

Flexible Enrollment: We have rolling payment and assessment systems, so there's no need to enroll at the start of Term 1. All-year enrollment is available subject to class spaces and mutual trial month success.

Key Dates

- Long academy holidays in June and December
- Indonesian national holidays observed
- Parent-teacher conference at the start of Semester 1 (Term 1)
- Student-parent conference at the start of Semester 2 (Term 3)
- 3 whole academy events each year: Halloween, Nyepi, and the Graduation Show
- 3–4 excursions per year for each class group

Extra Curricular Activities

After Academy Programs

We offer a variety of after-academy activities, often with professional sports coaching clubs:

Student-Led Social Clubs

Students also organize and run their own social clubs, including:

These activities provide opportunities for students to explore interests, develop skills, and build community outside the classroom.

Our students are being prepared to sit IGCSE exams via our Cambridge accredited partners. We use accredited resources for learning and assessment and we are fully DIKNAS registered. All subjects are taught by a faculty of experienced, fully qualified, licensed teachers.

Visa Options for Families Moving to Bali

Relocating to Bali is an exciting step for your family. Choosing the right visa is essential to ensure stability, continuity, and a smooth academy experience.

Student Visa (C316 → Student KITAS)

Available through Skyhawk Academy

Skyhawk Academy is able to sponsor student visas for enrolled families.

- Issued as a C316 entry visa, converted to a Student KITAS
- Provides legal residency aligned with academy attendance
- Designed specifically for families committing to education in Indonesia

Important: Student visa sponsorship is available after enrolment and successful completion of the Trial Month.

This is the most stable and appropriate long-term option for families attending Skyhawk.

Recommended Entry Route

Social & Cultural Visa (B211-type)

- Valid up to ~180 days (with extensions)
- Suitable for: initial relocation, trial period, settling into Bali

- Restriction: No employment or paid activity permitted
- 👉 Recommended as the initial visa before transitioning to a Student KITAS

⚠️ Important Guidance for Families

- Indonesian visa regulations change frequently
- This guide is general guidance only (not legal advice)
- Families must arrange visas through a licensed immigration agent — we can refer you to a recommended agent who works closely with the academy

👉 Skyhawk Academy will:

- Support Student Visa sponsorship (subject to mutually successful trial month)
- Provide general guidance based on experience

🎯 Key Recommendation

For families planning to live and study in Bali:

👉 **Do not rely on Tourist Visas** — They are short-term and do not provide the stability required for academy attendance.
