How We Measure Progress

IXL Diagnostic

Tracks each student from their own starting point — measuring how far they have come, not how they compare to others.

100 points = 1 year

150 pts = 1.5 years · 200 pts = 2 full years of academic progress.

Note on timing

IXL measures from 1 July. Students who joined mid-year have fewer months — their true progress is likely higher.

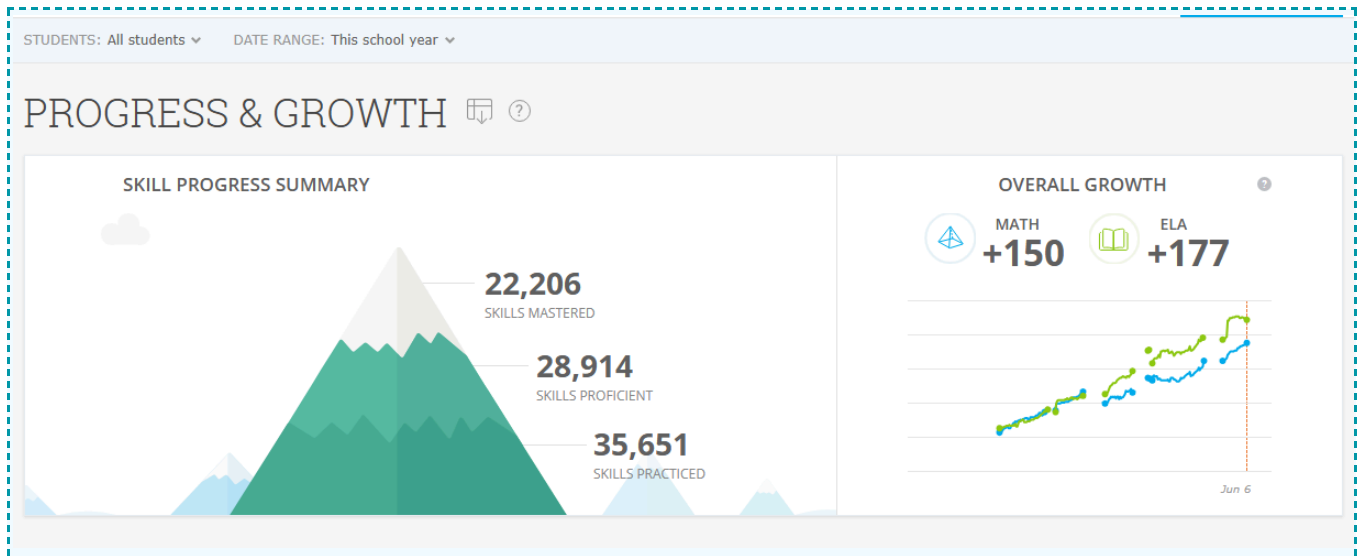
Progress vs School Target

The dashed line shows the school target of 150 points (1.5 years).

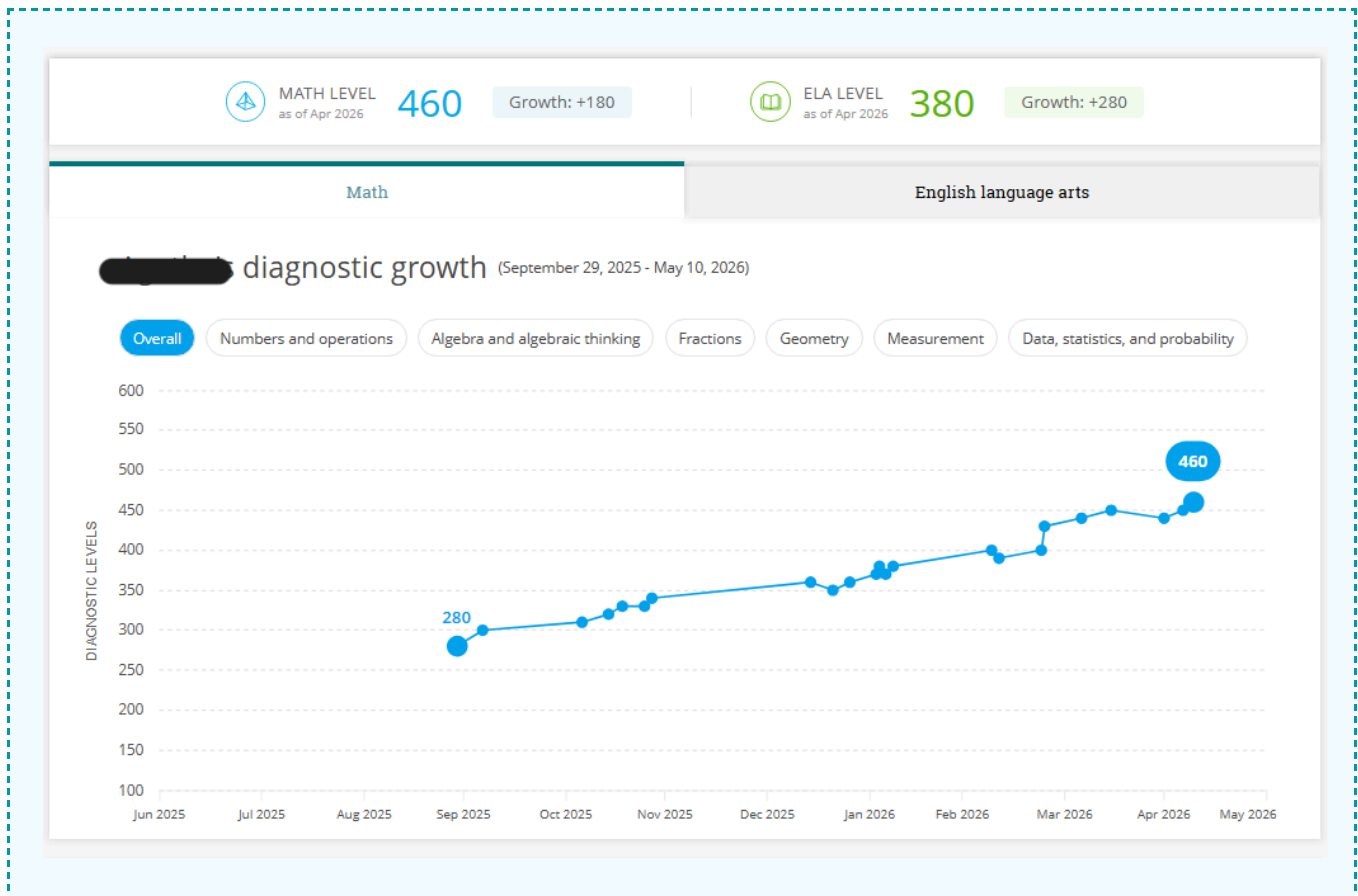

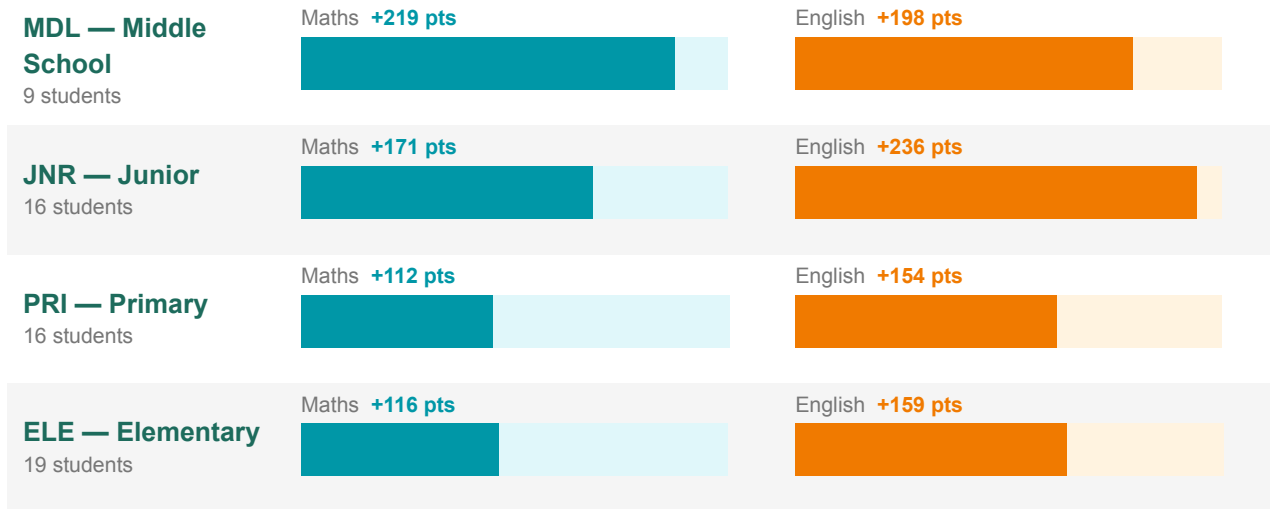
